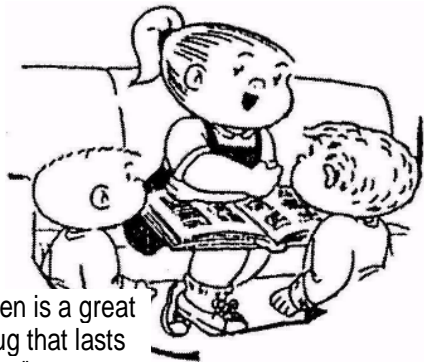

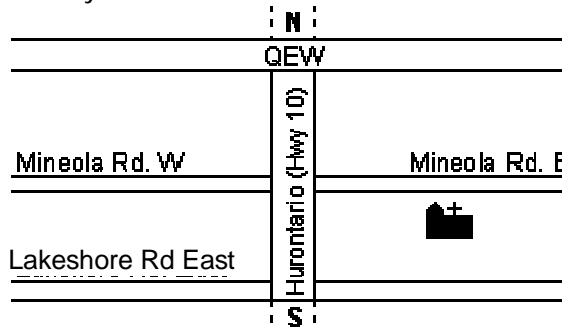

Program Philosophy

We provide a loving and warm environment to help your child become aware of his/her unique and special place as a person in this world

We foster a positive self-concept in all children and help them to develop spiritually, intellectually, physically, emotionally and socially



We provide a learning environment based on Christian values

Our program includes simple Bible stories and songs to teach your child about God and the world He made

We believe that children should discover learning as a life long process

Programs

Our younger children, aged 2 ½ to 3 years are encouraged to make choices independently, follow routines & directions, share toys, recognize their name and identify/ name objects, colours and shapes

Our children aged 3 to 4 years are offered opportunities to play/work cooperatively with others, to observe and make discoveries, to recognize their own name / peers and begin to identify numbers and letters

Our children 4 - 6 yrs (JK/SK age) are provided with a more structured environment that focuses on academic and play learning experiences. Children are provided with opportunities that will increase their abilities to problem solve, use planning skills, respect others, recognize numbers, letters, names and labels in the classrooms

More detailed curriculum goals are available for each age group.



Opportunities For Learning

Child / teacher directed opportunities for learning are provided through the following areas:

Creative: cutting, painting, pasting

Sensory: play dough, sand play, water play

Science: magnets, nature items

Dramatic: dress-up imaginative play

Table Toys: matching, lacing, sequencing

Floor Toys: castle, farm, blocks

Reading: theme related

Christian stories

Computer: age appropriate programs

Writing: colouring, tracing

Field Trips / Special events: theme days, walks, trips (i.e. African Lion Safari, Bronte Creek)
